Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type tine carriages rated by the blade carriage lifting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been the same.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is around thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type tines could be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
