In view of the fact that universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the equipment and are less vulnerable to destruction. These buckets are even 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads such as tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete and backfilling behind walls.
